

ORDINANCE # 1995-1

ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM SYSTEM
FOR NUMBERING PROPERTIES AND PRINCIPAL
BUILDING IN THE CITY OF MUNISING

The City Commission of the City of Munising hereby ordains:

SECTION 1. Uniform Numbering System

A uniform system of numbering properties and principal buildings, as shown on the map identified by the title "City of Munising 911 District Map", which is filed with the City Clerk, is hereby adopted for use in the City of Munising. This map, with the recitations therein, is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Assignment of Numbers

A. All properties or parcels of land within the boundaries of the City of Munising shall hereafter be identified by reference to the uniform numbering system hereby adopted; provided all existing numbers of property and buildings not now in conformity with provisions of this ordinance shall be changed to conform to the system hereby adopted by October 1, 1995.

B. Each principal building shall bear the number assigned to the lot or parcel on which the front entrance of the building is located. In case a principal building is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance of that principal building shall bear a separate number.

C. Numerals indicating the assigned number for each principal building, and, if required by subjecting(B), each front entrance to such building, shall be posted in a manner as to be visible and readable from the road on which the property is located. It is the duty of the owner of the lot or parcel to which a number is assigned to affix numerals to the building of a size and style that ensures the number is visible and readable as required by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Administration

A. The City of Munising shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system. The owner of each lot or parcel assigned a number shall maintain that number to comply with Section 2.

B. The City of Munising shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this ordinance.

C. The City of Munising shall issue to any property owner in the City of Munising a set of numerals for each principal buildings or separate front entrance to such building. In so doing, the City shall issue only numerals for the number assigned to such building under the provisions of this ordinance; provided, however, that the City may issue additional numerals at a reasonable cost to the property owner in accord with the numbering system hereby adopted whenever a property has been subdivided or developed, or a numeral sign is stolen or damaged.

D. All property owners shall comply with the terms of this ordinance. Failure to comply with the terms of this ordinance within 48 hours after written notification of non-compliance shall be a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Penalties

Violation of this ordinance is a civil infraction and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00. Each separate day such violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. Adoption

Adopted on this 21st day of August, 1995 by the City Commission of the City of Munising.

SECTION 6. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect on the 11th day of September, 1995.
